Local people have been skilled as accredited trainers in effective parenting techniques and are committed to mentoring and teaching other Islander parents. The mentors provide an enjoyable group for sharing parenting concerns with people who understand their experience as a Culturally and Linguistically diverse community member.

Pacifika Playgroup is a place where Pacific Islander children can interact in an educational setting early in life; providing them with a stronger base for their education. Pacifika Playgroup focuses with intention on culture and language to facilitate improved early educational outcomes for children.

* Pacifika will be a Hub for child and parenting education and services for Pacific Islander families in Deception Bay, enhancing awareness of, and access to other services such as health, immunisation, physical activities, community events, further parent training opportunities and cultural programs.
