

The **Murriajabree Indigenous Early Childhood Networker** helps families gain the confidence they need to access community and Child and Family services in Deception Bay. Through the support of the Networker, existing funded services are able for the first time to provide appropriate child and family support to Indigenous families. More babies and children are now accessing services such as vaccination, early childhood education, hearing and speech pathology screening and cultural activities during this critical stage in a human development.

The Indigenous Early Childhood Networker:

- * Knows their community and the child and family service network and links them to each other
- * Helps service providers provide services to families in culturally appropriate ways
- * Seeks future commitment of resources for Indigenous programs in Deception Bay.
- * Helps to run the Gundoos playgroup

- * The Indigenous Early Childhood Networker works with the library to increase Indigenous participation in library programs.
- * Promotes a cultural reconnection amongst Indigenous youth of Deception Bay; concurrently maintaining a strong diverse cultural community.
